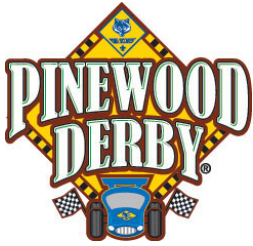
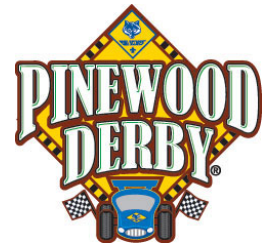

2015 DISTRICT PINWOOD DERBY RULES

Cars must be built using an official BSA car kit but add ons are allowed (*SEE ADDITIONAL RULES AT SCOUTTRACK.COM*).

CAR SPECIFICATIONS AND MEASUREMENTS:

WIDTH: Not to exceed 2.75 inches (7 cm)

LENGTH: Not to exceed 7.00 inches (17.8 cm)

WEIGHT: Not to exceed 5.00 ounces (142 gms)

HEIGHT: Not restricted but must fit under the District's finish line. Guideline height is 2.75 in. (7mm).

CENTER RAIL CLEARANCE: 1.75 inches (4.44 cm) minimum between wheels

BOTTOM CLEARANCE: A minimum of 0.375 inches is recommended.

WHEELBASE: The original axle slots do not need to be used. They may be moved to anywhere on the under-body.

NOTE: No modification of the insides of wheels in any manner is allowed! The car will automatically be disqualified.
