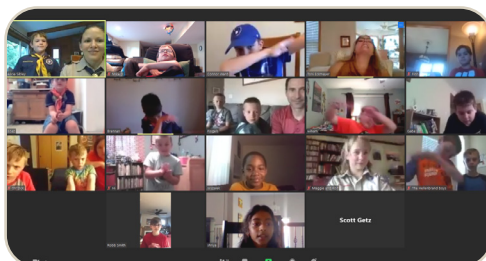
## Popcorn
